


Educreations for iPad




Educreations is a simple, free, reusable, recordable whiteboard that can be utilised by students or teachers.

Download it for your iPad here –

Once you have been to the app store and downloaded and opened the app you will be prompted to create a new lesson.

You will be taken to a whiteboard page that is quite similar to an IWB (see below)

This can be done either directly from the iPad camera, from stored photos (Camera Roll), an image stored in your Dropbox or an image from the web.





Add text in a typeface rather than handwritten

This function will bring up the iPad keyboard automatically.




When you have finished press Done and you will be prompted to save the lesson or start over. Select Save.

Educreations for iPad



Give the lesson a title

Decide if you want it public or seen only by the people you send it to or give the link to.

Categorise the lesson by subject and topic.

You need to create an Educreations account to do this but you can simply login with your Google Melba domain credentials by clicking the sign in with Google button

Type in your Melba Google creds here. **Just a note an email alias (if you have set one up) will not get you in**

Educreations for iPad



You will be prompted to allow access to basic account information.

(if for whatever reason you don't want to link these accounts just create an account separately at <http://www.educreations.com/>)

You can also choose a Facebook login but be aware that will not work at school.

You'll then be asked to nominate yourself as a student or teacher

Returning to the main screen of the app you will see your lesson here.

Click on the curvy arrow at the right top area of the screen to share your lesson

A little toolbar becomes visible under your lesson.

The left most icon allows you to generate a web link for your lesson that you could share via Compass or Weebly etc.



The second icon from the left like a little envelope allows you to email and embedded version of your lesson to someone.

Clicking the cog icon down on the lower right of the page allows you to integrate the saving of your lessons to Dropbox and Facebook
